Research need

This project aims to target barriers to private sector investment in the Canarium industry by:

- improving supply
- increasing efficiency in production and processing systems
- developing domestic and export markets for processed gally nuts.

Worldwide, around 300 million people depend on forests as their primary source of food, nutrition and medicine. In Papua New Guinea, the indigenous gally tree (*Canarium indicum*) occurs naturally throughout various lowland provinces. However, the emerging canarium industry is at a critical phase and needs to harness the momentum built by the current and previous research undertaken.

Overall, this project is assisting future growth in nut supply and to better understand the indigenous gally seed uses, which is developing more gally tree trees. In addition, the project is investing in developing new high value niche product concepts and market test these to broaden the market potential for investors.
